Water purification systems

The Union Government, under the Rajiv Gandhi National Drinking Water Mission (RGNDWM) plans to install stand-alone drinking water purification systems in 30,000 rural schools throughout the country at an estimated cost of Rs 200 crore during 2008-09. To facilitate this initiative, the Department of Drinking Water Supply on Sunday held an exhibition 'Stand-Alone Drinking Water Purification Systems', Bhabha Atomic Research Centre's (BARC) Desalination Division (Mumbai) head PK Tewari said. Around 27 exhibitors participated and showcased their latest technologies and products for best stand-alone drinking water purification systems.
